

SUMMARY OF THE 26TH NUCLEAR AIR CLEANING
AND TREATMENT CONFERENCE

The 26th Nuclear Air Cleaning and Treatment Conference was held in Richland, WA, on September 11-12, 2000. This biennial conference was attended by 103 technical experts from all over the world, and was sponsored by the International Society of Nuclear Air Treatment and Technology, the U.S. Department of Energy, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, and the Harvard School of Public Health.

Technical sessions were held on the topics of facility ventilation, radioactive airborne emissions, filtration and adsorption techniques, regulatory requirements and documents, and operational concerns. A 27th conference is scheduled for the fall of 2002, and will continue to provide a forum for air cleaning experts to exchange ideas, information, technology, issues, and issues resolution.
